




- Day 1: Arrive in Kathmandu. Transfer to Hotel.
- Day 2: Pashupatinath Ji darshan. Tour briefing on trekking, equipments and travel.
- Day 3: Early morning drive to Shyabrubeshi by deluxe bus. The journey is of 6 hours. Overnight in Shyabrubeshi. Basic Accomodation (twin sharing or triple sharing)












- Day 8: Drive to Yamdwar. Parikrama starts from here either by foot or pony. Arrangements of stay are at Darchen (basic accommodation) for people who wish to stay back. For others, first day trek starts on the same day to Diraphuk. Total trek 20km (approx.) Overnight stay at Diraphuk in mud houses.
- Day 9: Second day of Parikrama from Diraphuk to Zutulphuk. A slow climb over Dolmala Pass (5260m) and descend to Zutalpuk.

 Overnight stay at Zutulphuk in basic accommodation.



- Day 11: Drive back to Shyabrubeshi. Overnight stay in a Guest house.
- Day 12: Drive back to Kathmandu. Overnight stay in Hotel.
- Day 13: Take a flight back to destination from Kathmandu Airport.
